

SELPA funded services for LEAs that are not members of the SELPA

The SELPA Director shall allocate all resources granted to the Special Education Local Plan Area pursuant to Education Code. Resources will be allocated in accordance with policy and procedures adopted by the Governance Council. The SELPA desires to ensure that students enrolled in and attending member Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) are given priority in access to resources and funds.

An LEA that is not a member of the Shasta SELPA may purchase special education services from the SELPA, County Office, or a member LEA in order to provide the full continuum of placement options to students with disabilities. Nonmember LEAs must have a written agreement with the LEA providing a special education program or service prior to accessing that program or service. Such services include educational services, extra-curricular activities, and programs. The SELPA must approve any written agreement for a nonmember LEA to access a special education program or service that is directly funded by the SELPA.
